

Checklist for Seek & Find Exploration Activity While Exploring the Falls of the Ohio State Park

Check the items below that your team, partner or you found in the park.

Fossils:

- Horn Coral
- Crinoid (“cheerios” fossils)
- A colonial coral (coral in a colony; hexagon, honey comb, wasp nest, organ pipe; you can check each one)
- Brachiopod (shell or clam-like)
- Branch or worm-like coral
- Trilobite (3 lobed body; horseshoe crab-like)
- Kneecap coral
- Bryozoan (fantail coral; lace-like)

Trees:

- Cottonwood (fan or heart-shaped leaf)
- Sycamore (camouflage bark)
- Willow (lance-shaped leaves)

Birds:

- Great Blue Heron
- American Egret
- Bald Eagle
- Osprey
- Cormorant
- Black Crown Night Heron
- Vulture
- any Sandpiper
- any Seagull
- Mallard Duck
- Canada geese

Other items:

- Eroded coal pebble (“coal penny”)
- Asiatic clam (tiny shell)
- River snail shell (conical)
- Fish bones
- A live minnow or dead fish
- Bird feathers (vulture or white plumage)

Find the following:

- 1-2 items that you feel are visually unusual, rare, interesting
- 1-2 items which you feel have an unusual touch
- 1 item that has an interesting smell
- 1-2 items which you see in the distance that you feel are unusual
- one question about something that interests you
